




2nd Harvest Food Bank Cares for Pets TOO!

Safe Alliance Battered **Women's** Shelter

The Service Circle of the ECW is in the final stages of working with *Safe Alliance* to set up a service opportunity for the 2014-2015 year.

Safe Alliance is a battered women's shelter located in West Charlotte off the Billy Graham Parkway. The facility provides emergency care and shelter, then helps families transition to a new life. The length of stay for the women varies between a couple weeks up to 6 months. The purpose of the facility is to bring together the various services for battered women under one umbrella and is managed and funded as a partnership between the city, county and private donations. The facility houses 120 women and children. Each woman/family is assigned a Case Worker to coordinate their legal, financial and emotional needs.

The Service Circle is proposing a program for 2014-2015 which includes 1) providing intake baskets for new residents with living essentials for women and their children when they are first admitted, 2) providing onsite volunteer opportunities for ECW members and 3) inviting Kathy **Heatley, the volunteer coordinator, to visit St. John's to** speak to the ECW.
